Why this 'theme'?

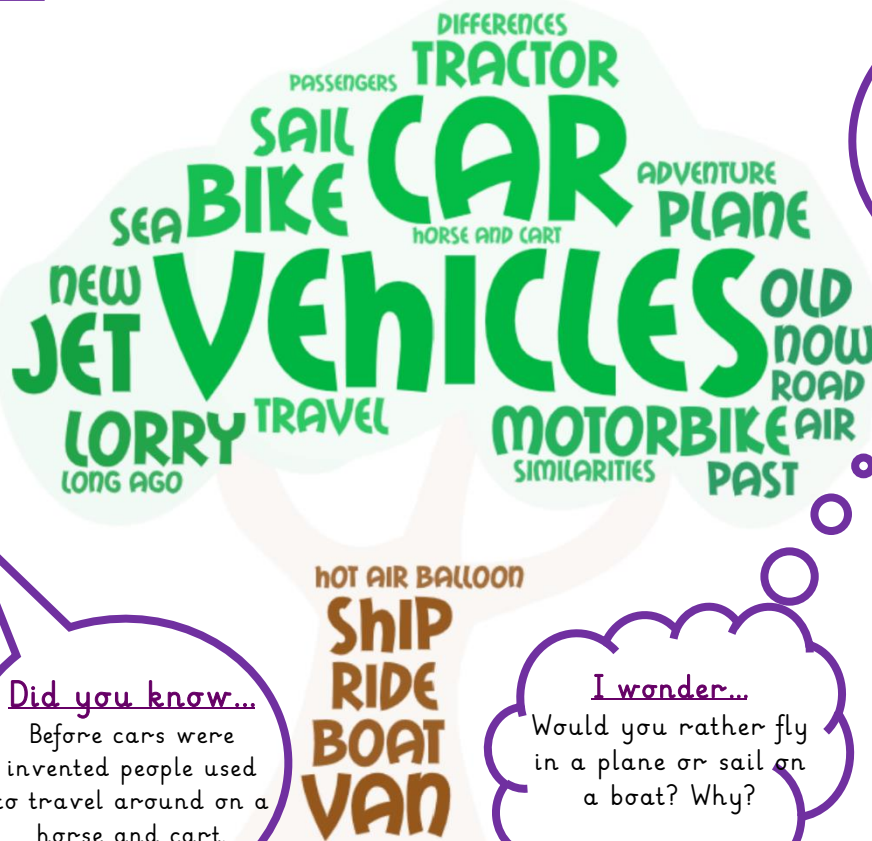
We have chosen this theme as the children have been very interested in different vehicles, including cars, trains and planes.

Present, past, long ago, sequence, before.



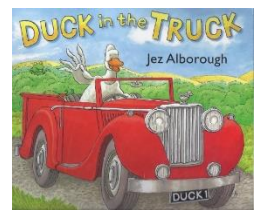
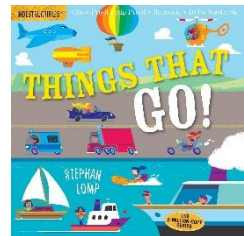
Did you know...
