 We are learning to read 'are' and 'her'.

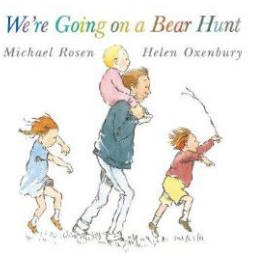
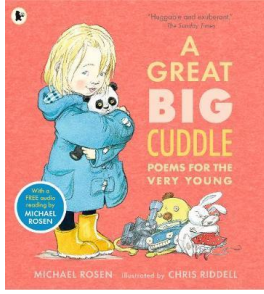
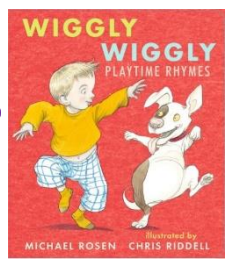
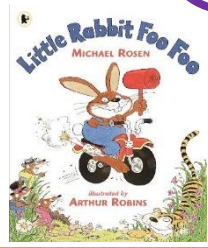
Why this 'theme'?
