We will be practising representing numbers to 5.

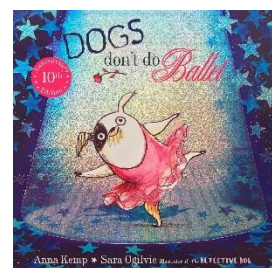
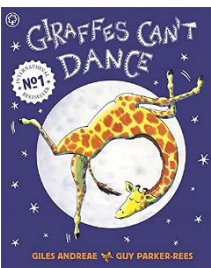
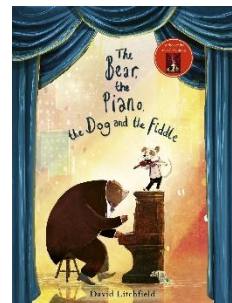
Skills Focus
