

### Dates




• Group 1 (Zog): Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> July to Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> July.

• Further details about timings for drop off and pick up are detailed in your information pack.





Thatching- to work as a team to construct a thatched roof.










Boat trip- to explore the wildlife on the broads and surrounding areas.

Environmental artusing natural resources to create art and sculptures.







- If you choose to give money to your child, a couple of pounds should be plenty.




### Expectations
