This week in maths...

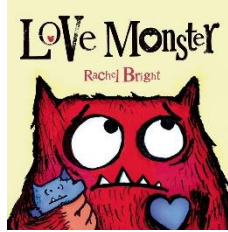
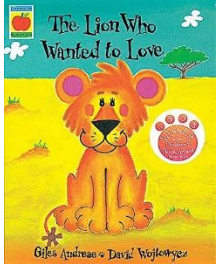
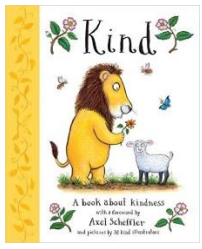
We will be finding, representing and comparing numbers 9 and 10.
