PSED -Exploring similar & different interests.

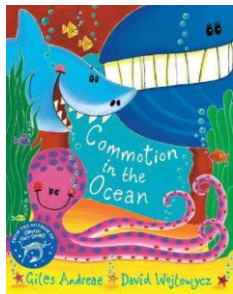
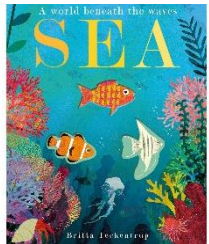

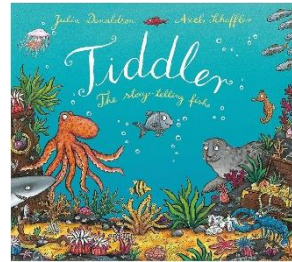


Did you know...
