Communication & Language: Sharing questions and ideas about a picture.

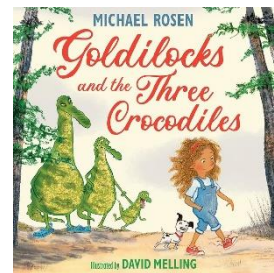
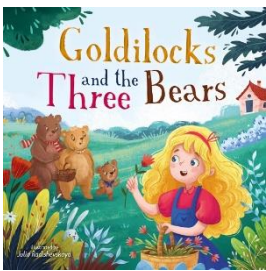
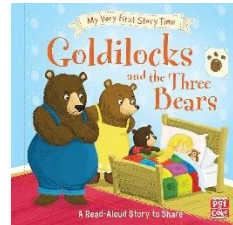
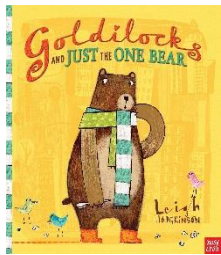
Key Vocabulary
