We will be exploring height, length and time.

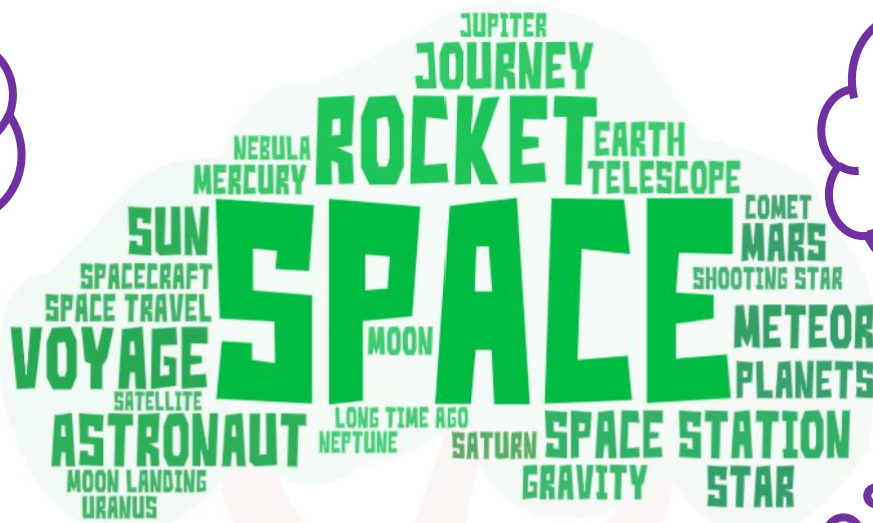

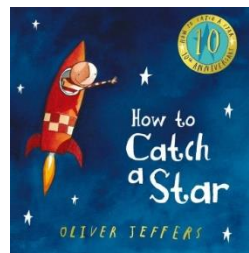
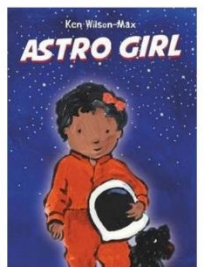
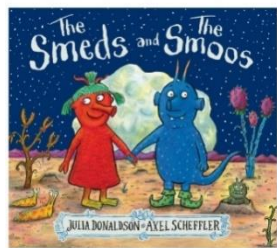
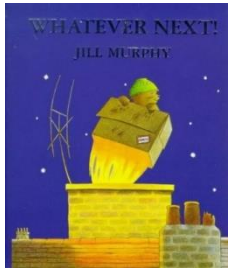


Did you know...
