This week in phonics...

We will be learning to read and write words/ sentences containing the digraphs 'oo', 'ar', 'or' and 'ow'.

We are learning to read the tricky words 'oh' and 'today', as well as learning how to spell 'as', 'a' and 'no'.

This week in maths...

We will be exploring number bonds to 10.

Why this 'theme'?

We will be spending the week immersing ourselves in fairytales stories as this is an important opportunity to explore characters, setting and plot.

Skills Focus

Expressive Arts & Design: Learning about safety and hygiene when eating food, make choices about porridge toppings and giving opinions. Singing the Goldilocks song, adding actions.

PSED: Making choices about things we like and dislike.

Communication & Language: Sharing questions and ideas about a picture, exploring the story of Goldilocks.
