This week in maths...

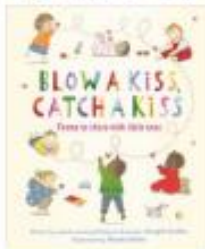
We will be developing our skills in sharing and grouping objects.
